The subcommittee for the rewiring project have met and the minutes are in the correspondence. We have decided to proceed with quotes for instillation as we don't believe we have the volunteers and skills to install the system. Darren Riggs (Nelson Irrigation) and 2 staff from Hugall and Hoile visited and met with Alan and Graham as I couldn't be there .They inspected the course regarding issues to do with instillation before they prepare a quote. Living Turf wish to quote on the supply of rewiring the course.</p>		

		<p>HR products who gave an indicative price for a wireless system also sell Hunter decoder systems and wish to quote as well.</p> <p>I have given them information they require but told them we need to have pricing by the end of the month so we can add it to our Greens grant application.</p> <p>Nhill Golf Club in Victoria has paid for 70 Rainbird sprinklers at \$50 and will let us know when to forward them to their nominated carrier.</p> <p>We have 47 second hand Rainbird sprinklers left to sell.</p> <p>Graham and I have inspected dirt to use on the fairways.
